What are Student Success Teams?

Student Success Teams (SST) is a state mandated school based committee to provide student services. After a teacher has attempted to address the problem in the classroom as well as through parent communication, he/she may seek assistance from the appropriate SST. At Edison High School there are four (4) grade level SSTs which meet weekly to address teacher and student needs.



Who are the Members of the SST?

The SST is comprised of specially trained members of the staff:

- ◆ Teachers
- ◆ Child Study Team Member
- ◆ Guidance Counselor
- ◆ Crisis Counselor
- ◆ Administrator
- ◆ Nurse
- ◆ Speech and Language Services



How Does a Referral Process Work?

The SST is a collaborative process designed to brainstorm solutions and aid both the teacher and the student.

- ◆ The concerned teacher initiates the referral process.
- ◆ A case coordinator is assigned to oversee the collection of educational data.
- ◆ The case coordinator collects relevant data and the parent is contacted regarding the SST process.
- ◆ The case coordinator meets with the SST and presents relevant facts, observable behaviors, and academic trends. The SST brainstorms and develops an action plan. A timeframe is established to see if the modifications and strategies are effective.
- ◆ The SST holds a follow-up meeting to review the case and apply the appropriate action.
